

It is resolved that, as per the Grade points fixed for B.Pharm and M.Pharm Courses for the 2013-14 academic year admitted batches onwards and present new PCI regulations implemented for 2017-18 academic year admitted batches, it is very difficult to issue Aggregate Percentage of Marks obtained by any candidate in the above courses by utilizing the multiplication factor or formula recommended by APSCHE for converting CGPA to Aggregate Percentage. The main reason for this is the minimum percentage of marks to be obtained by a candidate to pass in individual subject is 50% in respective Pharmacy Courses, whereas it is 40% in other Courses. Similarly Percentage of Marks to be obtained by a candidate to award First Class with Distinction is 75% in Pharmacy Courses, whereas it is 70% in other courses. Due to this, Grade Points and Letter Grades are varying. Hence, it is resolved and requested to recommend for issue of Aggregate Percentage Certificate to only the appealed candidates based on the original marks obtained in the respective Pharmacy courses. 2. 


