1. To discuss about the conversion of CGPA to aggregate Percentage of marks for B. Pharmacy and M. Pharmacy Courses following PCI Common Syllabus and Regulations from the Academic Year 2017-18 admitted batches onwards.
2. To discuss and request about the Ph.D admissions to be made under Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Acharya Nagarjuna University, by allotting Ph.D Scholars to Eligible Faculty of ANU Affiliated Pharmacy Colleges from the Academic Year 2020-2021 onwards.

Resolutions:

1. It is resolved that, as per the Grade points fixed for B.Pharm and M.Pharm Courses for the 2013-14 academic year admitted batches onwards and present new PCI regulations implemented for 2017-18 academic year admitted batches, it is very difficult to issue Aggregate Percentage of Marks obtained by any candidate in the above courses by utilizing the multiplication factor or formula recommended by APSCHE for converting CGPA to Aggregate Percentage. The main reason for this is the minimum percentage of marks to be obtained by a candidate to pass in individual subject is 50% in respective Pharmacy Courses, whereas it is 40% in other Courses. Similarly Percentage of Marks to be obtained by a candidate to award First Class with Distinction is 75% in Pharmacy Courses, whereas it is 70% in other courses. Due to this, Grade Points and Letter Grades are varying.

Hence, it is resolved and requested to recommend for issue of Aggregate Percentage Certificate to only the appealed candidates based on the original marks obtained in the respective Pharmacy courses.

2. It is resolved to submit the representation letter to the Registrar, regarding Ph.D admissions in Faculty of Pharmacy from the Academic Year 2020-21 onwards. (Copy of the request letter submitted is enclosed).

- b) It is discussed and resolved to conduct all Practical examinations including Projects, Clerkships etc. of various Pharmacy courses by deputing eligible faculty of the same Institution as both internal & external examiners to the same college for only this academic session. i.e., 2019-20 to avoid external faculty exposing to unforeseen contamination. - c) It is further resolved to allow the students to submit only the soft-copy of their thesis/clerkship book along with the Viva Presentation PPT to the concerned colleges to avoid unnecessary contamination involved in hard-copy preparation by external sources. Further the concerned college Principals are to be directed to submit the screenshots of the viva conducting procedure through online mode to the University authorities along with the marks award statements.
- d) It is further resolved to conduct the examinations in a simplified format by reducing the duration of examination, question paper pattern for enabling the students who were stuck up at various places and remain unprepared due to non-availability of study materials and due to prevailing Corona COVID situation. However it is left to the respected University authorities to decide the changes if any in conducting the examinations.
- e) It is also discussed and resolved to conduct Instant examinations during August 2020 for the outgoing B.Pharmacy (VII and VIII Semesters) students for those who may not be able to attend or failed the regular / supplementary examination to be conducted in July 2020 due to prevailing unforeseen situation. For such students, it is resolved to award the Class/Grade at par with the regular students for only this academic year.
- f) It is resolved to direct the concerned college authorities to take full proof measures like sanitization, restricting to a maximum of 20 students in each examination room by maintaining a minimum of 5-6 feet gap between the students and all other necessary precautionary arrangements while conducting the examinations.
- g) It is further resolved to review the status of lockdown situations by University authorities particularly about the opening of college hostels, travelling of students from various places and containment zones before conducting the examinations as per the tentative schedule.

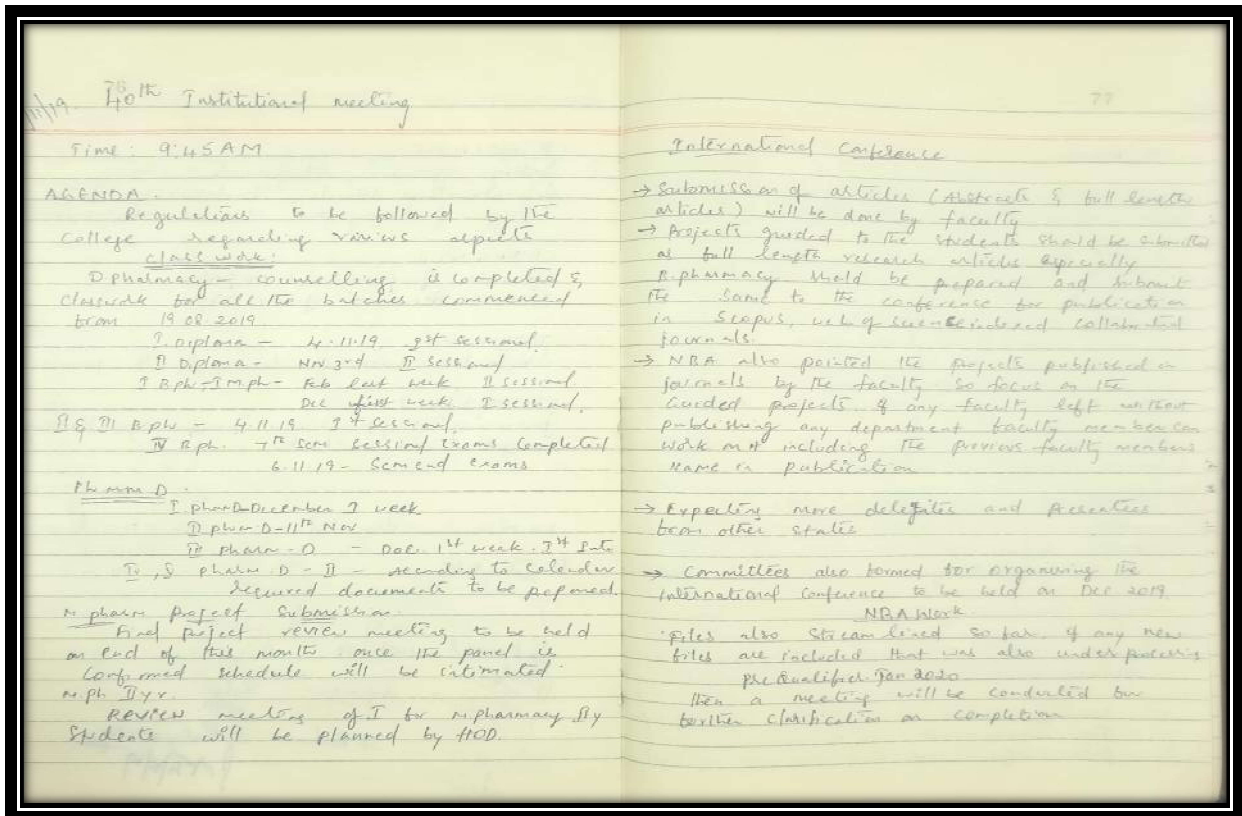

I. Basing on the PCI circular - No.14-382/2019-PCI, Dt.09.09.2019, regarding syllabus for B. Pharmacy Course clause-16 - Academic Progression with respect to detention system and the representations received from Principals of various Affiliated Colleges:

A). To follow the previously implemented B. Pharmacy examination rules of our University w.r.t detention system be continued for the Academic Years 2017-18 & 2018-19 B. Pharmacy admitted students only, who are actually studying PCI-New Course Regulations -2014, which were already implemented from the Academic Year 2017-18 admitted batch onwards.

B). The University rule position previously followed with respect to the detention system for the B. Pharmacy Course is as follows:

1. A Student shall be eligible for promotion to III year B. Pharmacy course, if he/she has passed all but Three subjects of I year B. Pharmacy course (1st & 2nd semesters put together including Practical Subjects) in addition to satisfying the minimum requirement of attendance.

2. A student shall be eligible for promotion to IV year B. Pharmacy course, if he/she has satisfied the minimum requirements of attendance in III year B.Pharmacy and has passed all but Three subjects of II Year B. Pharmacy course (3rd & 4th Semester put together including Practical Subjects) and passed all but one subject of I year B. Pharmacy.

II. The Strict adherence of PCI regulations -2014 be followed and implemented in toto for the students admitted from the Academic Year 2019-20 onwards.



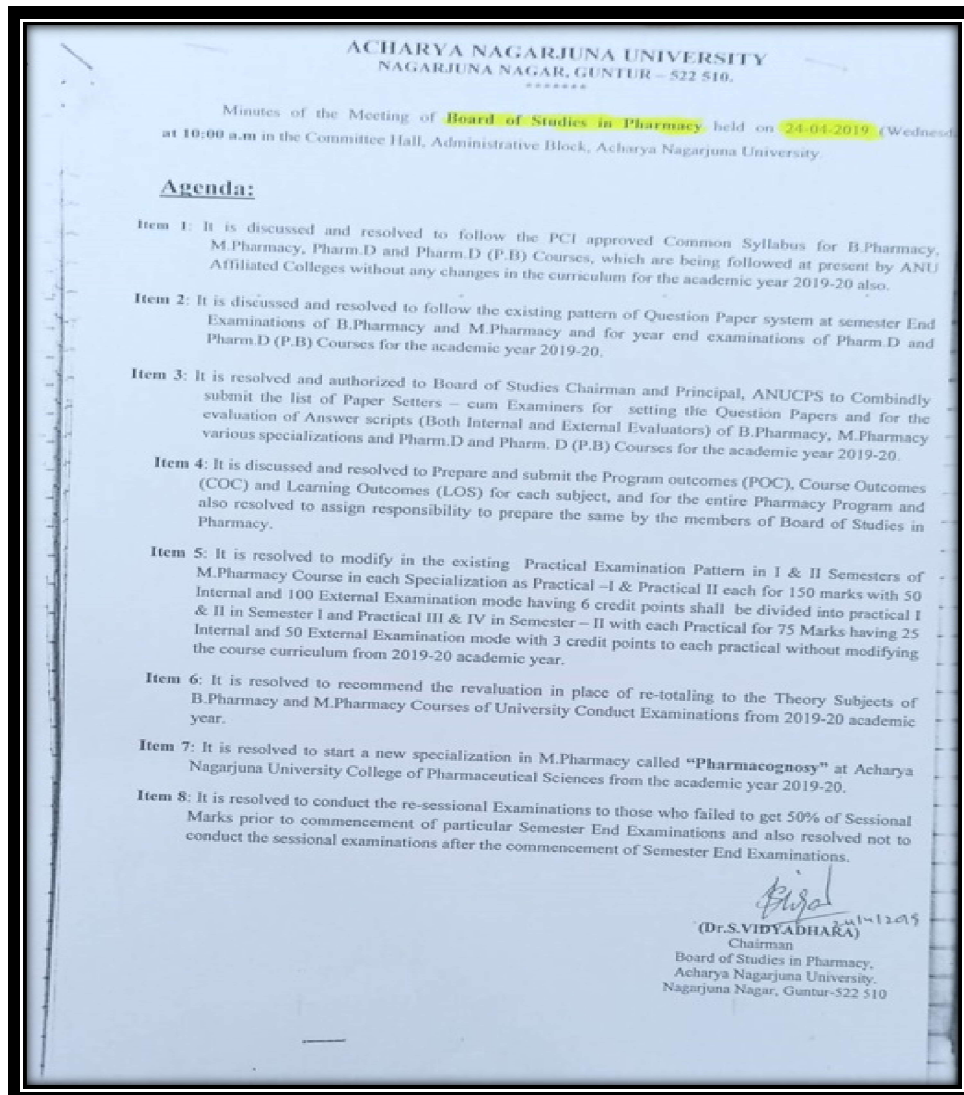
