

Quantitative structure-activity relationships (QSARs) are predictive statistical models correlating one or more piece of response data about chemicals, with the information numerically encoded in the form of descriptors. Various statistical tools, including regression and classification-based strategies, are used to analyze the response and chemical data and their relationship. Machine learning tools are also very effective in developing predictive models, particularly when handling high-dimensional and complex chemical data showing a nonlinear relationship with the responses of the chemicals. Some of the selected statistical tools commonly used in QSAR studies will be briefly discussed.
